Dr. Howard Shrobe is a Principal Research Scientist at MIT's Computer Science and Artificial Intelligence Laboratory. He received his B.S. from Yale College (1968) and his M.S. (1975) and his PhD (1978) from MIT. He has been a member of the staff of the MIT Artificial Intelligence Laboratory and its successors, CSAIL, since 1978. He has served as a program manager at the Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency (DARPA) initiating and leading large research programs on cyber security. He has served as Associate Director of CSAIL. His research interests include AI, Cyber Security (particularly of control systems) and new computer architectures for inherently secure computing.
